

1. Interdependence

Definition: Individual units are connected to each other in a larger system. Changes in one ministry will affect other ministries in the church and community.

Key question: What are the short and long-term effects of this action?

Key word: connecting

2. Multiplication

Definition: Healthy organisms do not grow endlessly, but reproduce themselves.

Key question: How does this contribute to multiplication, not just addition?

Key word: reproducing

3. Energy Transformation

Definition: Momentum or energy already flowing, whether positive or negative, can be redirected to accomplish God's purposes.

Key question: How can we utilize positive and negative resources to fulfill God's purpose?

Key word: leveraging

4. Multi-usage

Definition: Resources used should increase the capacity for on-going growth and development, as well as serve multiple purposes.

Key question: How do these actions contribute to future ministry cycles?

Key word: sustaining

5. Symbiosis

Definition: Different ministries can cultivate cooperative relationships so the mutual benefit is greater than operating separately.

Key question: How can we work together to enhance ministry effectiveness?

Key word: cooperating

6. Functionality

Definition: Each ministry needs to produce discernible results in line with its intended purpose.

Key question: How can we maximize the fruitfulness of this ministry?
