At Skyline we are implementing some precautionary actions and recommendations, which include:

- On Sunday mornings the upper doors will be open or someone will open them for you.
- Sanitizing wipes will be available.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the Involvement Center.
- Surfaces will be wiped down between use with virucide.
- Extra rows of chairs have been added in the sanctuary.
- Gloves are available in the upper kitchen area for those providing snack and coffee.
- We will continue to supply disposable utensils.
- Offering baskets will be handled by ushers only.
- All mics will be wiped down between use.
- Suspending use of a common cup during communion.

We also ask that you keep the follow recommendations in mind as you consider activities in and around our building:

- If you or any family member is experiencing flu-like symptoms, please do not visit the church at this time. If this results in you missing worship, remember we post the sermon live on Facebook.
- If you or any family member becomes ill with coronavirus symptoms, please notify Pastor Carm or Molly DeJuliis in our office.
- Wash your hands frequently, at least 20 seconds of scrubbing.
- Use non-contact methods of greeting.
- If you are inclined to use the water fountain, please consider washing your hands before and after.
- Avoid touching your face and practice proper cough/sneezing etiquette.
- Limit food sharing.
- Consider carrying your own sanitizer and wipes.
